About This Book

Inspired by a true event that occurred in the summer of 2015 – when an adorable new species of octopus was discovered on the ocean floor – this picture book story imagines how this cute creature got his name.

Deep down in the water lives an octopus small enough to fit in the palm of your hand. But he doesn't have a name! Anglerfish is named for his hook like an angler, Mimic Octopus for her ability to change shape and colour, and Giant Squid is GIANT! But this little guy doesn't have the same abilities as the other creatures. What could his name be? Youngsters will enjoy reading about how the cutest creature in the sea got his name. The story includes a note from a scientist about the naming process and additional facts about Adorabilis.
